

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Reporting Requirement Not Met for Tully Lake Campground

During the 2018 Season Tully Lake Campground failed to notify the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) that we completed the steps required to start-up our water system after we had been shut down for the off-season. We are required to notify MassDEP that we completed the required steps before we served water to the public.

Although this situation does not create a health risk, as our customers you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct the situation.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time. If a situation arises where the water is no longer safe to drink, you will be notified within 24 hours.

What is being done?

Coordination of startup procedure is being done between the Water System Certified Operator and the Campground Management to have all startup procedures completed with enough time to comply to all DEP Notification procedures.
