- Use only organic methods, supplies, and fertilizers
- Keep my plot tidy and relatively weed free, as not to be an obstruction to other gardeners
- Be considerate and respectful of other gardeners (do not stomp through another garden plot, do not pick produce from a neighbor's plot, no overly loud music, no pets in the garden, etc.)

Plots are available April-November. Plots are 8' by 20'. The Community Garden is enclosed with a deer fence. We provide access to basic garden tools and have three dedicated hoses for the Garden. Plots are \$60/season or free when you purchase a membership at the Farm. If you cannot afford a plot but would like to be a gardener, please reach out to Lindsay at LBrown@thetrustees.org

Please note, as a town property, all town laws also apply. If any gardener violates these rules they will receive a written warning and the FARM Institute reserves the right to deny access to the garden in the current season as well as future seasons.
