- Large, bushy plants
- Does well in dry soils

- With hints of citrus
- Prolific fruit in August-September
- 18" spacing



Jalapeno

- Big, dark green fruits
- Harvest when skin is cracking for hotter flavor, for mild flavor harvest when skin is green and smooth
- Prolific
- 18" spacing



Shishito

- Organic
- No heat
- Thin-walled
- Good roasted and in tempura, stir-fry, sauté, salad, and coleslaw
- May be used green or red
- Slightly sweet
- High yield

- Uniform fruits
- Classic shape
- Good flavor

- High yielding and dependable
- Ripens early
- Tender and delicately flavored
- Cooks quickly
- Germinates slowly






Tango

- No bulbs

- Strong roots
- Deals well with lowfertility soil
- Grow uniformly
- Resistant to heat and mildew
- Good side-shoot production

- Large, smooth heads
- Excellent wrappers
- Best in northern regions

- For mini-head production
- Proportional heads that fill out at true baby size
- Small size allows quick kitchen prep

- Continue growing through successive harvests
- Vigorous plants



- Resistant to corky root


Lettuce

- Edible flowers flavor is minty and spicy
- Attracts bees, butterflies, and hummingbirds
- Can be used medicinally to aid digestion and for its antibiotic-antiseptic properties

- Easy to grow
- Common coneflower
- Edible roots
- Perennial during mild winters

Brush Strokes

- Vigorous plant with abundant blooms
- Taller plants of varying heights
- Sweet fragrance
- Overwinters well without heating in hardiness zones 5 and higher
- Flowers are edible and can be candied

Viola


- Perennial in mild winters

- Yields multiple cuts over a season

- High yields 4-6" stem
- Dahlia-like blooms
- Great vase life






- Culinary and ornamental herb

- Organic
- Zesty flavor; resembles sweet marjoram, thyme and oregano
- Tender perennial

- Used in soups, meat dishes, gravies, and stuffing
- Use fresh or dried
- Perennial
- Aromatic green leaves

Gardening Tips from Your Local Farmer

- Use high quality soil and compost. We recommend a local nursery's option or Coast of Maine
- Fertilize (organic options available at your local nursery) and follow the instructions on the back of the package.
- Water depending on the weather. Ideally most crops want 1-2 inches of water a week. Plants don't need to be watered daily.
- Pay attention to the leaves! Discolored, curling, or rotting leaves
 offer information regarding the needs of your plants. Google is your
 friend here.

Gardening Tips from Your Local Farmer

- Create air flow in your garden by following appropriate plant spacing and pruning your tomatoes, cucumbers, eggplants, and peppers (cut lower, dead leaves or prune the suckers of the plant by watching one of the many youtube videos available)
- Respond quickly to signs of disease or pests.
- Buy high quality, locally adapted plants! We may be bias, but we think this is the most important tip we can give you. Large box stores over- fertilize their seedlings so they look more marketable, but quickly fail or "stunt" by the time they are established in your garden. Locally adapted plants may look smaller than box stores but will ultimately be less susceptible to diseases, and grow at a rate that is more appropriate to their natural life cycle.
