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Week One: Welcome to the 2026 CSA season!

Whether you're a returning member or are trying our CSA for the first time this year, thank you for joining us this season. We have a small team of just six farmers, so we all tend to become personally invested in each crop. One of the most rewarding parts of the year is finally sharing those crops with you: sharing the excitement, the favorite recipes, the stories. In May, it feels like we're six people growing vegetables, but in June, we realize that there are hundreds of us who care deeply about this food and this community. We are so excited to spend the summer enjoying the harvest with you!

The weather this spring has been great for getting plants in the ground. The snow melted quickly and the soil wasn't too soggy to work. We've been able to transplant most of our crops earlier this year than last, so we expect fruiting plants like cucumbers and tomatoes may come in earlier this season. Our early summer leafy greens, however, are growing fairly slowly since we haven't yet had an abundance of hot and sunny days. Our strawberries were also dormant well into the late winter due to snow cover, so they've had a slow start as well. You'll notice this weather impact in the first few weeks of your share; we'll start out with a small assortment of crops, but soon enough the variety should increase dramatically.

You are picking up at **Emerald City in Norwood**. Your pick-up day is Friday: 11AM-6PM.

This week your share will include:

- Spinach
- Carrots
- Lettuce Mix

Please note that while we do our best to predict what will be in your share each week, share content may be subject to change.
