Frequently Asked Questions 2026

Is Trustees membership required to book a birthday party at Weir River Farm?

Membership is not required. However, Trustees members at the Household level or higher receive a discounted rate. You may become a member or renew your membership

Nonmembers are charged the full rate.

How many guests may we invite?

You may invite up to 40 guests, including both children and adults. Infants in carriers may be excluded from the total count.

Where do guests park?

- **For parties expecting more than 10 vehicles:** Guests should park at 140 Turkey Hill Lane, cross the street, and walk along the path to the barnyard.
 - **For parties expecting 5–10 vehicles:** Parking is available at 227 East Street in the lot adjacent to the Red Barn.
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What should we bring?

We recommend bringing:

- Cake, candles, and a knife
- Snacks or lunch (e.g., pizza)
- Child-friendly beverages
- Plates, cups, utensils, and napkins (compostable or reusable preferred)
- Trash bags. This is a **carry-in, carry-out** property; guests must take all trash with them.

- Decorations
- Games, crafts, or activities

Weir River Farm does not provide food or supplies. Please note that as a working farm, no dogs are allowed at birthday parties.

What decorations are allowed?

The Red Barn classroom accommodates themed tablecloths, centerpieces, and birthday banners. Tables are 5 feet long, so please plan accordingly.

If you plan to decorate the 6-foot picnic tables outdoors, ensure all items are securely fastened.

Please note: Balloons are not permitted anywhere on the property.

What is included in my two-hour party time?

Your reservation includes a total of two hours on the farm, structured as follows:

- **15 minutes for setup**
- **45 minutes in the barnyard**
- **45 minutes for celebrating** (in the classroom or on the lawn)
- **15 minutes for cleanup**

For example, if your party is scheduled from **10:00–11:30 AM**, your access time will begin at **9:45 AM** for setup and end at **11:45 AM** after cleanup.

Please note that staff are not responsible for setting up or cleaning up your event.

Weir River Farm follows a carry-in, carry-out trash policy. A \$200 trash removal fee will be assessed if trash is left behind.

Does Weir River Farm staff supervise children?

A staff member will guide guests during the barnyard visit; however, staff are not responsible for supervising children at any time. Adult supervision is required throughout the event.

Are restrooms available?

Yes, accessible restrooms are located inside the Red Barn, adjacent to the party spaces.

Is accessible parking available?

Yes, accessible parking is available near the barnyard. Please inform staff in advance if you plan to use these spaces.
